Programs



Early Head Start provides an environment that is warm, nurturing, inclusive, and safe, with an enriching educational setting designed to allow infants and toddlers under 3 years old to learn and grow at their own pace, while parents are at work. Early Head Start is available at no cost for eligible families with children under 3 years old.

Head Start provides a high-quality foundational prekindergarten education that prepares students for longterm success with focuses on school-readiness skills, social-emotional development, and growth. Head Start is available at no cost for eligible families with children over the age of 3 years who have not reached Kindergarten.

School Readiness students receive the same high-quality education as the Head Start students and the program is offered at our Northern Fairfield County programs in Danbury. School Readiness is available on a sliding fee scale to families that do not qualify for the Head Start program.

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
